**ABSTRACT SUBMISSION DEADLINE: AUGUST 30 00:00HS (GMT-3)**

#### Rules for Submission

The content of the abstract should not have been previously published or presented at national or international meetings prior to this Congress.

Abstracts must be submitted online via the website only. ABSTRACTS SUBMITTED BY EMAIL WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED.

The Scientific Abstracts Committee will determine whether the abstract is accepted for E-POSTER presentation. Instructions for preparation of presentations will be made available on the congress website.

Abstracts must be received by the announced deadline. Abstracts received after the deadline will not be considered.

#### General Instructions

The First Author must submit the Abstract.

After acceptance, the First Author must submit the E-POSTER.

Submission of an abstract acknowledges your acceptance for the abstract to be published in the official book of abstract of the congress.

The first author is required to ensure that all co-authors are aware of the content of the abstract and agree to its submission, before submitting the abstract.

## Guidelines for Submission

All abstracts should be submitted and presented in clear English with accurate grammar and spelling of a quality suitable for publication.

Before you begin, since the submission form must be filled in one single step, please prepare the final version of your abstract and the following information:

Presenting author's contact details:

- First Author Full first and family name(s)
- First Author Affiliation
- First Author Email address
- First Author Phone number

Author and co-authors' details (Complete name and affiliations)

**Abstract title** – must be in UPPER CASE and limited to 25 words.

**Abstract text** – limited to 350 words.

**Abstract topic**-- select the abstract topic per the list of topics. Although the Committee will work hard to honor this selection, this cannot be guaranteed. The Committee reserves the right to change the Topic or Sub-Topic under which the abstract was originally submitted.

**Prize** – Consider whether you want to apply for the best three E-POSTER Congress prize.

Select YES or NO if your abstract applies for prize.

### Abstracts should clearly state:

- Background and aims
- Methods
- Results
- Conclusions

\*Use only standard abbreviations. Place special or unusual abbreviations in parentheses after the full word the first time it appears. Use generic names of drugs. The presentation must be balanced and contain no commercial promotional content. Submissions may not contain patient names, hospital ID numbers or other identifying information.

Click on the SUBMIT button at the end of the process in order to submit your abstract. After submission changes will not be possible.

You will receive a confirmation email of your submission.

After revision you will receive an acceptance email with further instructions for the E-POSTER.

### Abstract submitters' Declaration

During abstract submission you will be asked to confirm that you agree to the following:

Submission of the abstract constitutes the consent of all authors to publication (e.g. Congress website, programs, other promotions, etc.)

The contact details saved in this system must be those of the presenting author, who will be notified about the status of the abstract. The presenting author is responsible for informing the other authors about the status of the abstract.
